## OPPORTUNITIES FOR JANUARY 2016

### **J**WT JONES TRAVELLING FELLOWSHIP *Royal Society of Chemistry*

#### **Description:**

The Royal Society of Chemistry invites applications for the JWT Jones travelling fellowship. This enables younger chemists to carry out short-term studies in well-established scientific centres abroad and to learn and use techniques not accessible to them in their own country.

Candidates must have been members of the society for at least one year and should be under 45 years of age. They must hold at least a doctorate in chemistry or related subject and should already be in post and actively engaged in independent research. Applicants are required to return to their country of origin upon termination of the fellowship so that the applicant's home country may benefit from the broadened knowledge acquired during the fellowship.

The fellowship is worth up to £5,000 over one to three months to cover travel and subsistence.

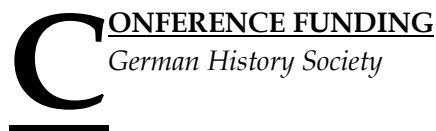

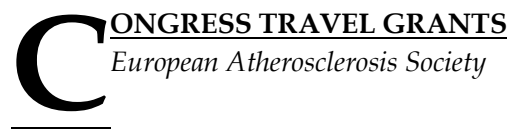
